

The Danbury One Day Activity Experience Easter 2010

Information for Parents and Guardians

The Day

The One Day Activity Experience offers young people aged 8 and upwards the chance to enjoy up to four new and exciting activities throughout the day. The activities vary from day to day and are listed in the attached programme; you can of course visit as many times as you like, subject to availability. Places are limited so book early to avoid disappointment.

Cost

The cost of each day is £25 per child.

Booking Process

Please contact the centre on 01245 223 342 or visit the centre in person to check availability and make a booking. Payment can be made by cash, cheque or credit / debit card at the time of booking. Please make cheques payable to Essex County Council. The booking is subject to the terms and conditions set out in the attached Consent Form.

Registration

Participants should arrive at Danbury at 09.00 and be accompanied by a parent/guardian until registered at the registration desk. Please ensure you bring the attached Consent Form with you did not complete it at the time of booking.

If you are attending multiple days you only need to complete one consent form but we will check at registration that we have the correct emergency contact details for that day. We will also check if the medical conditions declaration is up to date.

You must also inform us if an alternative adult will collect the young person. Please be advised that in such cases the alternative adult will need to provide identification. Activities will finish at 16:00 and participants can be picked up between 16:00 – 16:30 from the registration desk.

Lunch:

Participants should bring their own packed lunch and drinks for the day. Drinking water is available throughout the day, but there is no shop or food available on site. Please ensure that participants bring adequate food as the days activities can be strenuous and energy levels must be kept up to avoid fatigue.

Equipment and clothing

All specialist equipment will be provided.

Participants should arrive in clothing suitable for physical activity and should consider the weather forecast for that day - clothing may get wet, dirty and worn! We therefore advise participants to wear old clothes and bring waterproofs. It is particularly important that participants wear appropriate footwear, i.e. an old pair of trainers.

If your son or daughter is involved in open canoeing during the day, please ensure they bring a complete change of clothes with them, including footwear.

Danbury Outdoors takes no responsibility for the loss or damage of personal items, and we therefore advise that mobile phones/MP3 players etc are left at home.

Emergencies

In the event of an emergency we will contact you or your nominated contact person as soon as possible. If you need to contact your child/ward at any time, call the office on 01245 223342 or visit the main reception and we will contact your child/ward immediately.
